PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Town of Paris and the Village of Somers will hold a joint public hearing on April 7, 2016, at 7:00 p.m., in the Kenosha County Center Hearing Room, located at 19600 75th Street, Bristol, Wisconsin, at the intersection of Highways 50 and 45.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to gather public input regarding a proposed Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement"), which the Village and Town have proposed to enter into pursuant to Wis. Stat. Section 66.0301 for the purpose of establishing a planning process, management structure, marketing plan and revenue-sharing plan to encourage sound economic development of the I-94 Corridor Neighborhood Plan Area. The Agreement will:

- Adjust and establish a mutually agreeable jurisdictional boundary between the communities;
- Apportion assets and liabilities between the communities when lands are transferred;
- Allow the communities to jointly analyze the feasibility of providing for on-site sanitary sewer and water service; and,
- Allow the communities to share revenues generated by new economic development and as well as the apportionment of expenses involved.

The Town of Paris and Village of Somers Boards believe that this approach will provide the greatest mutual benefit to the citizens of both communities and to Kenosha County.
