



COUNTY HIGHWAY S EAST FRONTAGE ROAD TO WIS 31

Project Update

September 23, 2020



- Deck pour completed on the County Highway S bridge over Canadian Pacific Railway.
- Storm sewer and pipe culvert installations nearly complete along the new westbound lanes between County Highway H and Brumback Boulevard.
- Curb and gutter completed between the Canadian Pacific railroad bridge and just west of Brumback Boulevard.
- Stone base placement has been completed at several locations throughout the project for the new westbound lanes.
- Regional stormwater pond excavation nearing completion.
- Stone base placement at the County Highway H widening north of County Highway S complete.
- Work underway at WIS 31 & County Highway S for curb, sidewalks, curb ramps, and pedestrian walk signals at the proposed crosswalk.
- Grading, stone placement, loop detectors and curb & gutter complete for Brumback Boulevard & County Highway S intersection.
- Grading, base placement and culvert pipes complete for 96th Avenue connector.
- Mainline County Highway S grading and base placement complete at 38th Street intersection.
- Utility relocations nearly complete throughout the project.
- Pile driving complete on the bridge over the Kilbourn Ditch.

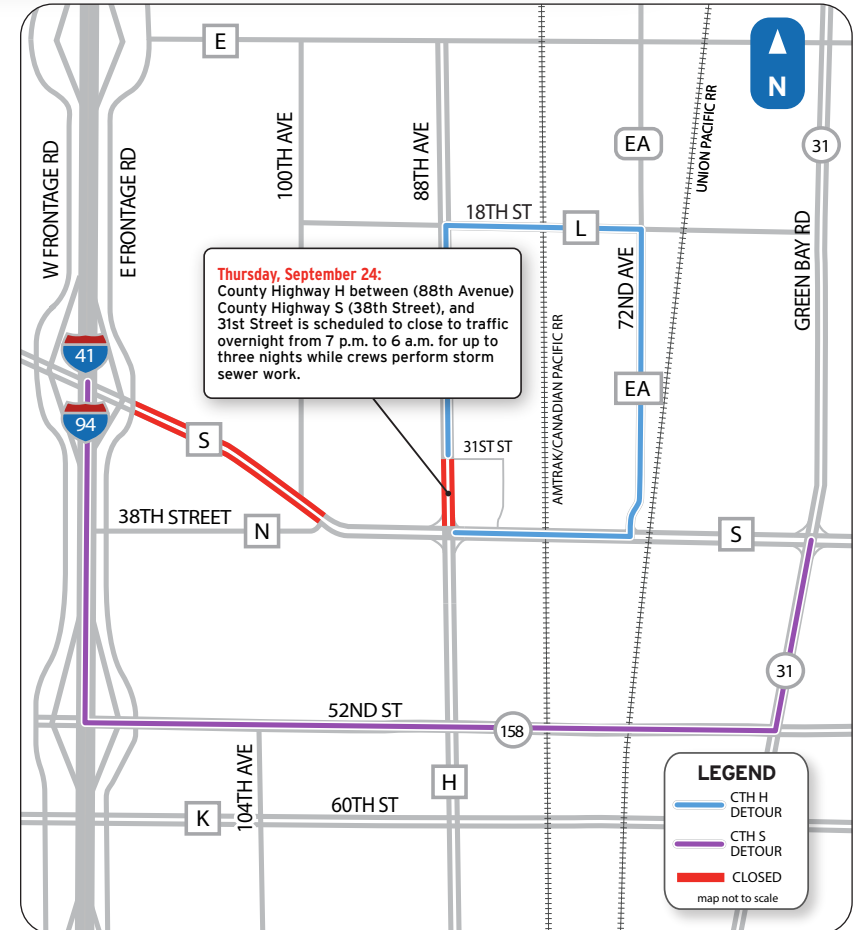
UPCOMING CLOSURES

Thursday, September 24:

- County Highway H (88th Avenue), between County Highway S (38th Street) and 31st Street is scheduled to close to traffic overnight from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for up to three nights while crews perform storm sewer work.

Detour Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to utilize County Highway H (88th Avenue), County Highway L (18th Street), County Highway EA (72nd Avenue), and County Highway S (38th Street) to get around the closure.
