

Diamond Grinding Operations to Begin

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) continues to progress on the WIS 31 (Green Bay Road) project from WIS 50 (75th Street) to County S (38th Street), which began in early April with completion scheduled for late fall. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of the project.

Monday, June 19, 2023:

- Diamond grinding operations are scheduled to begin on WIS 31 (Green Bay Road) between WIS 50 (75th Street) and County S (38th Street).

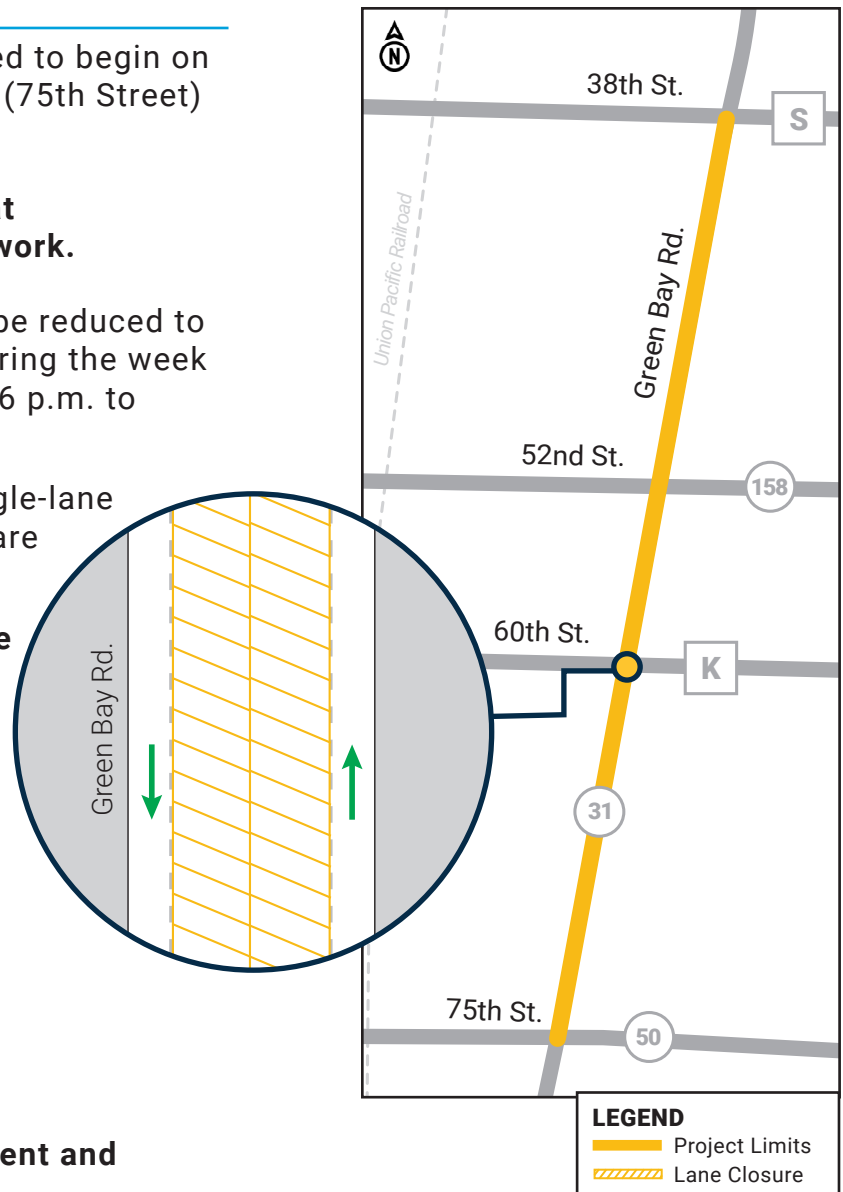
Business and residents should be aware that noise and dust will be associated with this work.

- WIS 31 (Green Bay Road) is scheduled to be reduced to be one lane in each direction overnight during the week from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. and weekends from 6 p.m. to 10 a.m., for approximately four weeks.
- During peak traffic hours, intermittent single-lane and turn lane closures along the corridor are scheduled to occur.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout the project.

Motorists should be aware that dedicated left turn lanes throughout the project are scheduled to close to traffic during the overnight lane closures.

Travelers should be aware of new traffic patterns, obey traffic control signs, and drive safely throughout the work zone.
