What is accepted:

Prescription (controlled and non-controlled) and over-the-counter (OTC) medications, ointments, patches, inhalers, non-aerosol sprays, creams, vials and pet medications. Vape pens or other e-cigarette devices (batteries removed).

NOT accepted:

Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, acids, aerosol cans, biohazardous materials, (anything containing a bodily fluid or blood), personal care products (shampoos, soaps, lotions sunscreens), household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas), mercury thermometers.
